Ulster Aviation Society Monday, 15th June @ 7:30pm

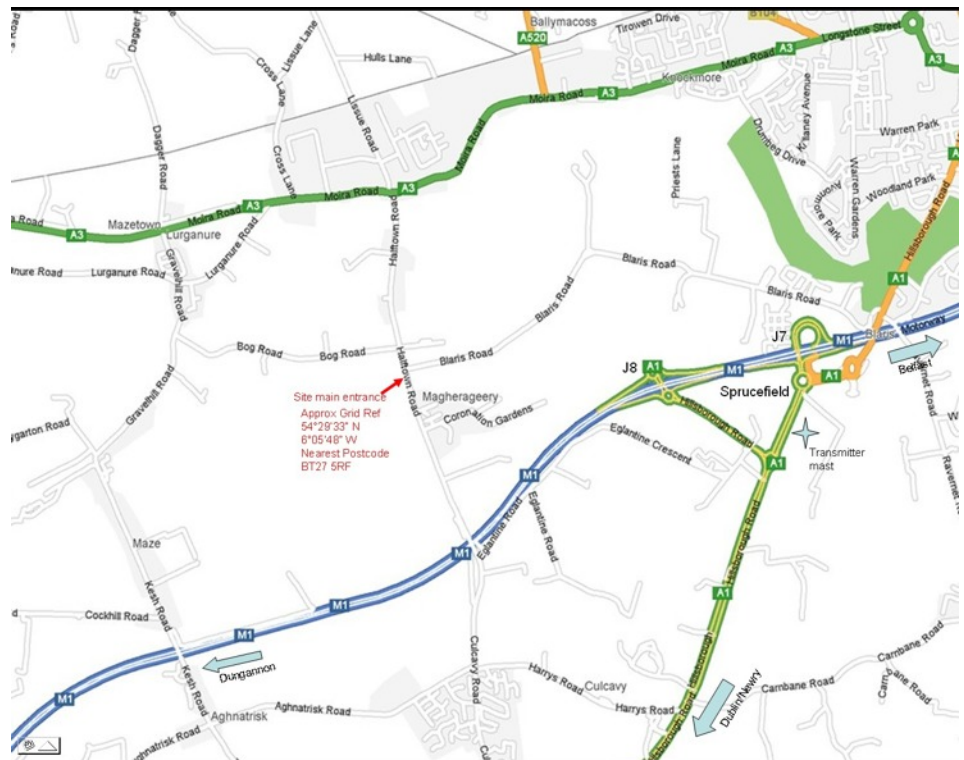
Join us on the 15th June at the Ulster Aviation Society in Lisburn where we will be given a guided tour of the collection.
